### What's changed?

#### GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) Changes

As a result of changes introduced by GDPR, we have amended the Data Protection cover under the Public liability section of your policy and increased the limit to £1,000,000 in any one period of insurance. Please refer to your policy wording for full details of the changes.
